A Shaker kitchen for a modern lifestyle

AYLESBURY VALE

This elegant modern in-frame Shaker kitchen was designed for clients that live in a detached Georgian house in Buckinghamshire. They wanted the kitchen to have modern features and contemporary appliances but for the look to be in harmony with the rest of their property.

Ornate architraves surround each of the leaded light windows that feature recently restored wooden shutters on either side of the deep set window sills. The bespoke kitchen cabinetry was designed, made and hand-painted in Farrow & Ball heritage colours to perfectly complement these original features. We incorporated lots of storage including a

pantry cupboard, a bi-fold breakfast cupboard, pull out drawers for pots and pans and open shelving for cookery books in the kitchen island. We also included a breakfast area with built in Shaker style tongue and groove bench seating within the kitchen itself.

Miele cooking appliances were chosen for this project with a French door fridge freezer by Fisher & Paykel and a concealed extractor canopy by Siemens. The worksurface is 30mm Andromeda White Granite with sharks' nose edge detail. The double bowl sink is from 1810 Company, the mix lever tap is by Perrin & Rowe, plus a Boiling Water Tap by Quooker.

A Shaker galley kitchen in a converted schoolhouse

WENDOVER

This long galley kitchen was designed for clients that wanted a space that reflected the beauty of their converted schoolhouse in Buckinghamshire. The original kitchen in the property was small and dark so we removed the original low ceiling to expose the beamed vaulted ceiling above. This visually increased the aspect, making it feel twice the size and gave the room a stunning traditional look.

We designed and made all furniture which was hand-painted in Farrow & Ball colours. We included a long run of framed hand-painted tall cabinets with stopped chamfer detailing on the doors in which a bank of

Siemens ovens is housed with a warming drawer. To complement the black-painted beams, all the worksurfaces are featured in gloss black granite with a cut out for a double undermount sink.

At the far end of the kitchen is an integrated dresser with decorative shelving and a deep red glass splashback. On the other side of the kitchen a solid oak breakfast bar was added, with seating beneath that looks out to the garden. In keeping with Shaker styling, Cotswold ball knobs were used for the cupboards while cup pull handles were used for the drawers.

A white Shaker kitchen in a Listed country cottage

STOKE GOLDFINGTON

We were commissioned to design a modern Shaker family kitchen in a Grade II Listed Georgian cottage in Buckinghamshire. Our clients wanted a light, bright space that would be in keeping with the architecture of the property and to retain an existing AGA in the original exposed brick fireplace that also heated the home.

The kitchen cabinetry was hand-painted in brilliant white throughout and complemented by Pure White Caesarstone worksurfaces. LED lighting was fitted inside the decorative glass-fronted overhead cabinets and above the plinths to provide additional illumination. The kitchen island was designed to provide additional storage including pan and utensil

drawers and to be the social centre of the kitchen. We handmade the bespoke freestanding dining table in walnut which fits in the window nook and we added walnut shelving. An original log store was thoughtfully converted into a modern pantry larder.

To solve the issue of cooking when the AGA was switched off during the summer, we installed an induction hob and a bank of ovens by Siemens and square metal handles were used to balance with the stainless steel appliances. A white Perrin & Rowe Belfast sink was installed with taps by Perrin & Rowe and Quooker.

KITCHENS

A Shaker kitchen with an island and a peninsula

WATFORD

This bespoke kitchen was designed and made for clients that had purchased the former country home of cookery writer, Fanny Craddock who taught the nation to cook during the 1950's to 1970's. It was a full refurbishment project, which included recovering the curved walls in exposed reclaimed brickwork to bring the look of the room up to date.

This in-frame hand-painted Shaker kitchen combines built in and freestanding furniture in Farrow & Ball heritage colours with a mix of wooden and finger pull handles. Together with a kitchen island with shelving for

cookery books, the design also features a separate peninsula for food preparation and additional storage and all have solid oak oiled worksurfaces. For this kitchen we also created two handmade freestanding pantry dressers and we also included exposed oak shelving on a wall of tongue and groove panelling to enhance the Shaker scheme.

A chequered mosaic splashback in glass, slate and stone complements the chequerboard marble flooring, which combines with the black AGA in the inglenook that has a wide firemantel above it; a feature of English Shaker kitchens.

Luxury in a London apartment

GREEN PARK

This contemporary bespoke kitchen is situated in a luxury apartment in an imposing Victorian building in Central London. Our clients wanted a glamorous handleless kitchen featuring a range of sumptuous textures and we chose a colour palette of chocolate brown, bronze and black to create a rich and dramatic effect.

The tall cabinetry was constructed using chocolate coloured concrete doors, with all internal cupboards featuring a luxurious finish using a matching leather textured material. While the kitchen is handleless with soft-close doors and drawers, long bespoke handles open the Gaggenau tall fridge and freezer. We designed satin bronze matt glass door fronts

and then made splashbacks in the exact same colourway and we used an aged bronze finger rail plate to tie the colour scheme together. The overhead cabinetry features electronic lift systems which close automatically by touching a sensor.

All worksurfaces are Vanilla Noir by Caesarstone, which has a pale vein running through the darker stone that picks out colours from the cabinetry. All integrated cooling, dishwashing and cooking appliances are by Gaggenau. The sink is by Kohler with a bespoke matt black Quooker Flex Boiling Water Tap that was outsourced to be specially finished.

Open plan opulence in London W1

MAYFAIR PENTHOUSE

We were appointed to design this open plan kitchen in a deluxe duplex apartment in a Listed Victorian property in Mayfair. While the kitchen space was limited, the specification was to be of the highest order featuring fine textured materials and Gaggenau appliances throughout.

The bespoke cabinetry is finished in book-matched Fiddleback Sycamore veneer with a grey stain which contains a shimmering silver sheen. The contrasting neutrals are all brought together by the Nero Marquina marble which features a pale vein throughout the dark stone. This is used as the worksurface and also for the peninsula that

separates the kitchen and living space, whilst affording views from either aspect. There is a food preparation area with an induction hob and downdraft extractor. A Kohler sink and Quooker Flex 3-in-1 Boiling Water Tap are also included in the opposite wet area. The floor to ceiling tall cabinetry houses two Gaggenau ovens and a warming drawer with a fridge freezer positioned along this run.

Facing the kitchen is informal seating next to a wine conditioning unit, perfect for entertaining. To add a dynamic contrast to the linear uniformity of this kitchen, three pendant lights are installed above the peninsula.

A linear kitchen with a floating peninsula

BERKHAMSTED

We created this natural veneered kitchen with a contemporary linear design for the family home of an architect. We featured American black walnut throughout, with a book-matched horizontal grain for a seamless and stylish finish.

The first base run extends from the wall to become a peninsula supported on a steel framework which provides a floating effect from a centre anchor. This includes the scribing and end panels in Zodiac Cloud White Quartz, which is also used for all work surfaces. This run of cabinetry incorporates the dishwasher and a set of different height drawers with stainless steel bar handles.

The tap by Gessi cleverly swivels round so the undermount sink can be accessed from both sides; ideal for food preparation. Behind is a wall of tall cabinetry including a pull-out larder for condiments and dry goods. This also houses a Siemens combination microwave and an American fridge freezer. Further overhead cabinets also feature lift-up doors.

The alternative base run features deep drawers, which is segmented by a large stainless steel Mercury range cooker and range hood above. Floating glass shelves to the right add a touch of simplicity and a long metal knife rack adds a professional look.

SOULBURY

For this contemporary scheme our clients requested a simple, elegant kitchen with clean lines that retained a sense of warmth and luxury. It is in a room with an entire wall of glass doors leading directly out to the garden, thus achieving a lot of natural daylight.

To reflect the light, we created a warm grey satin glass-fronted kitchen, which included mitred glass end panels to ensure that no unsightly edges were on view. Timber accents are included in the cabinetry to complement the original polished wooden floor. The kitchen layout features floor to ceiling cabinets against a back wall with a built-in tea

cupboard that has push-away doors to allow for additional workspace and housed within the run is a bank of Siemens ovens installed at waist level for easy access.

The satin grey glass linear kitchen island has an integrated circular walnut breakfast table extending to a cantilever breakfast bar at different heights. The white Caesarstone worksurface includes a food preparation area with an undermounted sink and hot tap by Franke, with 90cm Siemens induction hob for surface cooking. A ceiling extractor is integrated into the specially created top-lit circular bulkhead above the island.

A glamorous kitchen diner in a former Stately Home

PURLEY

Having been previously converted into apartments, the kitchen is located in a former drawing room in this stunning Georgian property. Our clients wanted a new contemporary state-of-the-art industrial style, reminiscent of a professional restaurant kitchen.

We designed and made all the tall brushed stainless steel kitchen cabinetry. This is used for storage and also houses a run of integrated cooling models including a wine climate cabinet together with a bank of ovens by Gaggenau. To maintain perspective with the very high ceiling, these are all three-metre-high structures and are top lit with LED lighting.

Between two large windows is a specially built tall steel storage cabinet with pocket doors at the central section that fold back into recesses to reveal a fully stocked bar and a concealed flatscreen TV.

At the centre of the room is a long steel island with a worktop in Concrete by Caesarstone. This is attached to L-shaped bench seating with stained ash pilasters for the dining area to complement a bespoke freestanding stained ash dining table. Facing the door are overhead cabinets to accommodate all glasses and stemware featuring four stained glass panels that we designed, which are inspired by the works of Louis Comfort Tiffany.

A stunning kitchen with a floating island

POTTERSURY

Our clients wanted a large open plan kitchen that would complement the stunning oak beams in the converted and extended barn. They had an existing white AGA, so we suggested the cabinetry to be finished in horizontal book-matched American black walnut veneer with white worksurfaces to deliver a dramatic linear aesthetic.

The layout of the kitchen was informed by the very symmetrical space. We placed the large island on the central axis directly below the main structural beams facing the window at the far end of the room. By then using a structural steel base, we cantilevered the

island away from the floor to give it a floating appearance. The positioning of the Miele induction hob and wine coolers in the island make it extremely functional whilst being visually stunning.

The long outer run was kept at low level so as not to distract from the structural elements and lighting. The white cabinetry to the centre of the book-matched walnut tall cabinets also keep with the design ethos. The Quartzforms worktops were chosen to match the exposed stone work on the original house wall and the teal glass splashbacks add a welcome splash of colour to the refined palette.

Contemporary Scandi-style open plan kitchen

BUTLERS CROSS

This unique custom-designed open plan handleless kitchen comprises part of an existing 1930's property which has had a large gabled extension added on to it, while part of the old building was demolished to accommodate the changes.

Our clients were keen to have a clean contemporary kitchen, but with something unusual and special about it. We created a monochrome scheme with gloss glass fronts on the island and base cabinetry. Pale sterling silver eucalyptus and vine tree bespoke veneers were used for the tall cabinetry, the built-in pantry larder with a sliding door and a breakfast cabinet with bi-fold doors. It was

also used for accents surrounding the glass door fronts, thus providing a sophisticated Scandinavian look to the room.

This unique design features a large floating L-shaped steel cantilever island and a floating L-shaped steel cantilever peninsula with mitred glass end panels. 20mm quartz worksurfaces by Quartzforms in Twinkle were used throughout. These included cut outs for the hob and also for the Kohler Icerock ice trough that sits behind the double sink within the kitchen island. Integrated handleless cooking and cooling appliances are all by Miele, with two Dishdrawer dishwashers by Fisher & Paykel.

En suite bath and shower room in a country mansion

SOULBURY

Our clients wanted to convert an existing spare bedroom into a luxurious en suite bath and shower room to complement their main bedroom. The result is a dramatic light and open area; perfect for relaxation.

We created an open plan free-flowing space that includes a walk-through shower, freestanding bath, twin basins and storage. All bespoke walnut cabinetry was designed and made at our workshop and we both sourced and hand-painted the bateau bath in a unique copper effect. This complements the walnut panelled bath wall that incorporates a thermostatic control and hand shower outlet. The twin basin areas feature floating

walnut storage cupboards beneath, which are decoratively styled with tiled upstands and include wall-mounted taps and lighting. Square Memento basins by Villeroy & Boch are complemented by the circular mirrors above. The towel rails are by Zehnder Chatsworth.

The shower area features book-matched porcelain marble effect tiles throughout, with anti-slip versions for the floor. The clear glass shower screen and the shower enclosure feature a waterfall shower head, accompanied by a second hand-held shower outlet, for convenience. The wall colour is decorated in heritage paint by Farrow & Ball.

BATHROOMS

A master en suite bathroom in a Victorian home

APSLY GUISE

Our brief was to create modern bathroom with separate shower area to suit the traditional architecture of the property and to include a vanity area with lots of storage.

Fitted storage cupboards were designed in a traditional style using cot beaded in-frame cabinetry with ogee moulding for the door and drawer fronts. To maximize storage, the bespoke dresser cabinets with internal shaver points were made full height to run along one full wall and into the side of a framed shower enclosure. The vanity area was kept to a minimal depth by using wall-mounted basin taps by Perrin & Rowe in a marble

splashback above an undermounted basin by Villeroy & Boch. This allowed enough space to include a black and white freestanding roll top bath to be situated on the other side of the long narrow room. A high-level cistern was specified for the WC and a towel radiator emphasize the traditional aspects of the scheme and reflect the period of the property.

Retro Metro tiles are featured on the walls and Crema Marfil marble is used for the floor which has underfloor heating. It is also used for the vanity worksurface and the shower enclosure which includes brassware by Perrin & Rowe.

BATHROOMS

A butterfly bathroom for a little princess

HERTFORDSHIRE

Having been commissioned to create a fairytale bedroom for our client's young daughter, we were also engaged to convert the next-door bedroom to an en suite bathroom. She had a love of butterflies, so we included them in the design by using an antique finish cream paint and then hand-painting each butterfly separately.

The central focus is the handmade vanity cabinet with split turned pilasters and a traditional skirted plinth with a cut out to create bracket feet to make it seem freestanding. Above is a frieze surrounding the mirror leading to a plinth block to

accommodate wall-mounted taps by Perrin & Rowe. The basin is set into a marble work surface, while Crema Marfil marble is used for the floor. A large cupboard with double doors is at the base with a false drawer above it that ensures the basin is completely concealed when the doors are opened.

To continue the theme, we created a framed triple mirror surround within a recess, which also features hand-painted butterflies. Directly beneath is a highly polished pewter bateau bath under wall-mounted bath taps, also by Perrin & Rowe. On either side are two bow fronted chrome towel rails.

A romantic bedroom with gothic detailing

BROMLEY

This project was a commission to refurbish a large family house in Kent for which we also made the furniture for the bathroom and dressing room. Our clients wanted an elegant and romantic look with lots of architectural detailing in a Neoclassical style and this was continued throughout the scheme. Our team of craftspeople were able to utilise all their cabinetry skills to handmake the wardrobes, the headboard and the freestanding bedside cabinets, which were all hand-painted in an antique paint finish.

The wardrobe takes up an entire wall with two glazed gothic arch doors on either side

of a carved central break-fronted linen press with a fluted frieze that has panels and bolection door mouldings. This features tall turned reeded pilasters that wrap around the cabinetry and the doors and drawer fronts have beaten pewter knobs.

The headboard features beautiful panelling and a centrally carved pediment at the top, reminiscent of the style from the Baroque period. Each of the bedside cabinets has matching bolection mouldings and a glass inset top. They both include a shallow dovetail drawer above a deep drawer below.

A bespoke master bedroom for a Victorian home

APSLEY GUISE

We were commissioned to design and make luxury bespoke fitted wardrobes and furniture for a south-facing bedroom with a large recessed window in a detached Victorian house.

Our clients wanted the room to be light and relaxing, to have plenty of storage and for some contemporary twists to be included within the traditional scheme. All handmade in-frame furniture has cot bead detail and was hand-painted in Slipper Satin by Farrow & Ball. It was skirted with ogee mouldings and features a classic cornice scribed to the ceiling with panelled door end panels and curved corner pilasters to soften the look.

All drawers feature oak internals with dovetail detailing and all wardrobes feature a mix of drawers and hanging rails, with an additional pull-down rail. The freestanding bedside cabinets and radiator covers are presented in the same design and hand-painted too.

Further concealed storage is featured in the two window seats with pull-out drawers either side of the recessed window, together with an ottoman style box at the end of the bed that incorporates a pop-up slimline TV that is hidden when not being used. LED spotlighting is perfectly placed to make a feature of the furniture at night.

DRESSING ROOMS

Deluxe dressing in a beautiful boudoir

ELLESBOROUGH

As part of a sympathetic refurbishment to an Edwardian manor house, we were asked to convert a bedroom to become a dressing room on a mezzanine level between the second and top floors. As part of a newly planned layout, this was to lead from a new en suite bathroom that we also designed, which in turn leads to the main bedroom.

The dressing room, with steps up from the en suite, features cabinetry designed to complement the Edwardian architectural style of the house which has tall windows in every room. This comprises bolection moulded doors which are set into a cot beaded frame.

There is a plain frieze above with a beading detail running around the top. The split turn pilasters create a break-fronted feature, which has a mitred detail on the traditional dentil cornice that runs along the top of the cabinetry.

The key requirement was storage for clothes, shoes and accessories that could be concealed behind the wardrobe doors. At the centre of the room is an island seating area with storage for shoes, which can also be used for laying out clothing. The room was hand-painted in cream with a special antique finish.

Based at Cane End Works in Bierton, our large joinery workshop is where our team of craftspeople translate our designs to make all the timber cabinetry used in our furniture. We have invested in state of the art machinery to cut mouldings cornices and pillars, and at every stage of the process each piece is quality-checked and then hand-finished with a hard-wearing satin lacquer, or it is hand-painted in your chosen colour.

As trends have evolved we have also developed the expertise to make furniture with matt or gloss glass door fronts, with concrete in bespoke colours and using stainless steel. If you have a special finish in mind, we will source it and make it for you.

Our cabinetmakers have a wealth of experience and take great pride in their work. Where possible they will visit the site to see the finished results. In this way, we continue to improve our products and processes to meet the needs of our clients.
